

## **A601b Unattended Children**

*Last updated: February 2023*

Responsibility for children using the library rests with the caregiver/guardian, not with library staff. Young children need constant supervision which the library cannot provide. Any child aged seven or younger must be directly supervised at all times by a responsible adult or caregiver at least 12 years old. Unattended children under age 8 or any child requiring repeated intervention by library staff or who are violating the [A901b Public Code of Behavior](#) may be asked to leave and library staff may contact the caregivers, guardians, or the police.
